Yes, we have desires, but when does desires come in conflict of His need for us we become idolaters.

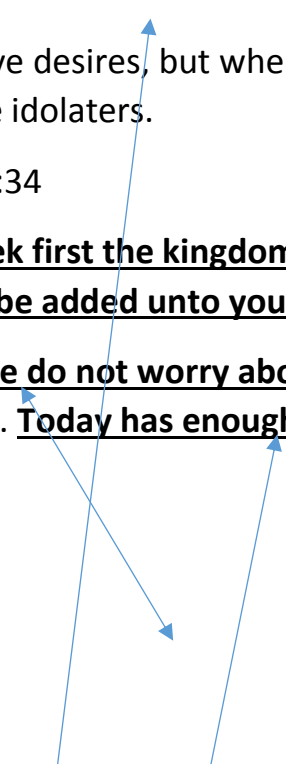
Matthew 6:34
